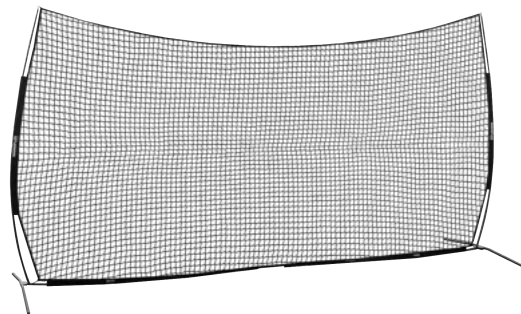
RHINO FLEX BARRIER NET

Instructions:

The Champion Sports Rhino Flex lacrosse backstop barrier net is a must-have piece of equipment for lax coaches, parents and athletes.

1. Locate the middle hinge bracket of the metal frame and unfold. Figure 1a thru 1d
2. Unfold the two side legs and snap into place (repeat opposite side). Figure 2
3. Slide telescoping legs outwards until locked and repeat the opposite side. Figure 3
4. Insert 1 steel pole into the frame post and repeat opposite side.. Figure 4
5. Take 1 lower fiberglass pole and one upper fiberglass pole and insert it into the net sleeve. Figure 5a & 5b
6. Attach the top net loop over the upper fiberglass pole. Figure 6
7. Insert fiberglass poles with the net attached to lower steel poles as shown and repeat steps 5-7 on the opposite side. Figure 7
8. Attached the lower net Velcro strap onto the metal base frame as shown. Figure 8

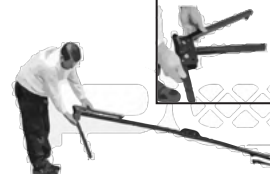

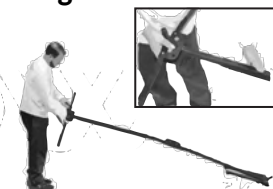

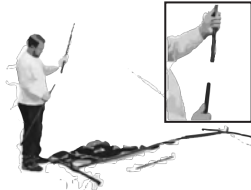

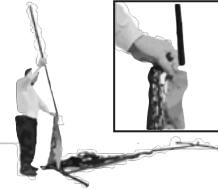

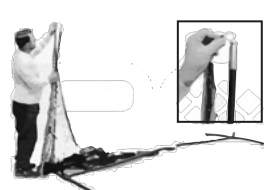

WARNINGS:

- Only use and set up with adult supervision.
- Do not drag. Use two people to move the net.
- Do not leave net set-up unattended, overnight or for extended periods in inclement weather.
- Keep fingers away from hinges and joints.
- Only use a flat thumb to depress buttons.
- Net must only be used for the sport for which it was designed for.
- Replace damaged or missing parts IMMEDIATELY.
- Never climb or hang on the net or framework. Always keep net securely anchored with stakes or sandbags. An unsecured net can fall over causing serious injury or death.
