

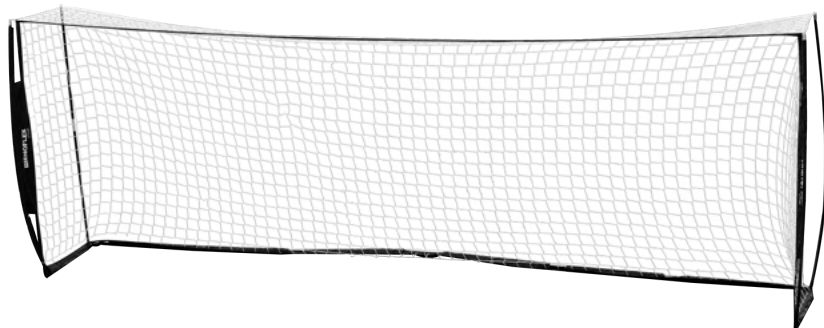

RHINO SOCCER GOAL

Features:

- Rhino Flex technology
- Easy set-up without the use of tools
- Includes goal netting
- Powder coated steel frame
- Goal is USSF regulation size for U9 - U12
- 6'5" x 18.5'



Instructions:

Take your soccer game to the next level with the lightweight but durable Rhino Flex Portable Soccer Goal.

1. Place the double hinge on the ground with the net spread out away from you. Open one half of the frame resting it on the ground. Figure 1
2. Take half of the frame each, lowering them onto the ground. Figure 2
3. Open the outside frames of the net until hinge locks-clicking sound. Insert bungee cord, stakeholders. Figure 3
4. Join Poles together (see A) Take 2 of the 4 poles and feed them into the black 'front post' sleeves and slot them into the front tubes on the frame. Figure 4
5. take the 2 front Net Loops and place over the tops of the front Poles. Note: Pushing the poles towards each other will remove tension. Figure 5
6. Place the loops over poles using your pole holding thumb. Figure 6
7. Insert two rear Poles in the frame. Repeat #6 with rear Loops. Figure 7

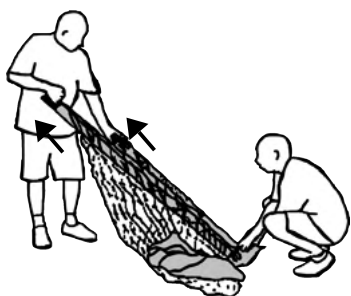

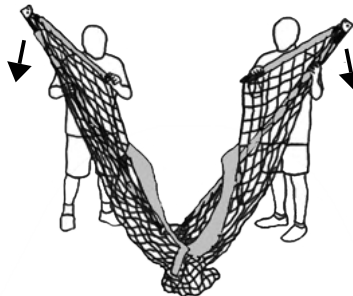

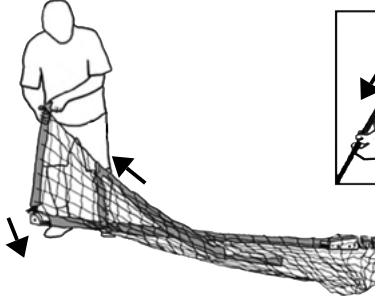

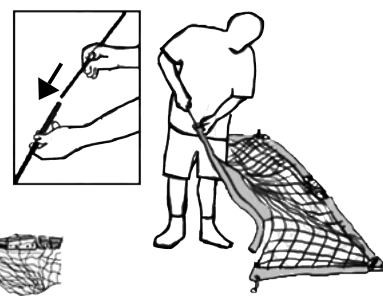

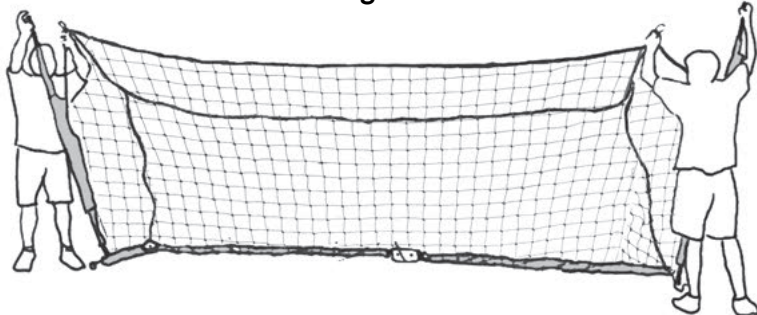
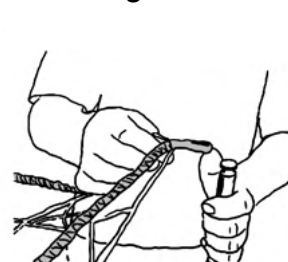

PARTS:

- 1 Main steel frame with net attached
- 8 Fiberglass poles
- 2 Bungee cord stake holders
- 2 Stakes
- 1 Carrying bag

WARNINGS:

Only use and set up with adult supervision. Do not drag. Use two people to move net. Do not leave net set-up unattended, overnight or for extended periods in inclement weather. Keep fingers away from hinges and joints. Only use a flat thumb to depress buttons. Net must only be used for the sport for which it was designed for. Replace damaged or missing parts IMMEDIATELY. Never climb or hang on net or framework. Always keep net securely anchored with stakes or sandbags. Unsecured net can fall over causing serious injury or death.
