Instructions:

Easily create sidelines, end lines or goal lines with the Champion Sports 65 lb four-wheel dry line marker.

1. Assemble the handle bar Ⓑ by sliding the two pieces together, ensuring the notched plate Ⓕ is on the top left. Figure 1.
2. Position the handle assembly and bucket brace onto the bucket aligning the holes. Figure 2.
3. Connect the adjustment rod Ⓒ by sliding the end of the rod through the adjustment handle Ⓓ all the way through until the rod can be rotated down to position the end into the adjustment lever Ⓔ near the front wheel. Figure 3.
4. Insert the end of the adjustment rod Ⓒ through the adjustment lever Ⓔ and secure in place with the cotter pin ⓵. Figure 4.
